Be it ordered by the Board of Health of Highland County General Health District, State of Ohio, that on **December 1, 2016**, pursuant to Section 3709.09 of the Ohio Revised Code for a recreational vehicle parks, recreational camps, combined park-camps and temporary park-camps, as defined in Section 3729.01 of the Revised Code, that the annual fee for the cost of licensing, inspecting, and enforcing laws and regulations pertaining to the operation of said parks and camps be set as authorized by Rule 3701-26-05 of the Ohio Administrative Code and based on the number of sites, as followed:

Park – Camp License

50 or less sites	\$404.00
