1. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by Mr. Edgington at 9:15AM.

2. Roll Call

3. EH and Nursing Stats

The Board reviewed monthly activity from EH and PHN Division.

4. WPCLF Grant Jobs

Mr. Warner reviewed ongoing grant jobs with the board. After discussion, Mr. Edgington made a motion to approve the completion of the grant funded projects for the Jessica Shepherd and Tammy Smith properties. Dr. Karnes seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

5. Nuisance Complaints

- Mark Massie – Massie Water Hauling – Mr. Webb described ongoing and repeated problems with Massie Water Hauling operating without the required registration in place. After discussion, Dr. Karnes made a motion to refer this issue to the prosecutor. Mr. Edgington seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.
- John Richardson Nuisance



- Mr. Webb provided an overview on a nuisance located at 220 Greenbush Rd. at the residence of John Richardson. Mr. Webb made a trip to the property and verified that a household septic system failure has led to a sewage release into a roadside ditch, which travels in front of the neighboring home. It appears that the aeration motor failed at some point, leading to the discharge of untreated sewage from Mr. Richardson's system.
  - The neighboring home owner, Jim Bratton, placed a large load of gravel in the ditch in an effort to reduce the appearance and odor of sewage.
  - Mr. Richardson has pumped out the system and replaced the aerator motor. The gravel placed over the normal effluent area now prevents Mr. Richardson or the health department from verifying that the nuisance has been abated.
  - Mr. Bratton is concerned that the removal of the gravel may result in a release of currently retained sewage into the ditch, creating a larger sewage nuisance.
  - After considerable discussion, Dr. Karnes made a motion to require Mr. Richardson to provide a plan of action to the health department for how he will determine the proper operation of the system without creating a larger sewage nuisance in the process. If no progress from the homeowner on this case is observed, the issue will be forwarded to the prosecutor for further action at Mr. Webb's discretion. Mr. Edgington seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.
- Andrew and Betty Hostetler – Sewage Nuisance – 4821 Bennington Rd. – Mr. Shope observed sewage on the ground from a surface discharge pipe that had been connected to the Hostetler residence. Sewage is being discharged from the residence. After discussion, Dr. Karnes made a motion to refer this issue to the prosecutor. Mr. Edgington seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

#### 6. July 2020 BOH Minutes

Mr. Warner presented the minutes for the July 2020 BOH Meeting. Dr. Karnes made a motion to approve minutes. Mr. Edgington seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

#### 7. Bills from July 15, 2020 to August 20, 2020

Ms. Page presented the bills from July 15, 2020 to August 20, 2020. Dr. Karnes made a motion to approve the bills. Mr. Edgington seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

#### 8. Legislative Review

Mr. Warner provided an overview of an Ohio Senate Bill that would potentially alter the makeup of BOH membership, as well as create other changes to BOH structure.



9. Quality Improvement

- Single Entry Way Updates – Mr. Warner reported on recent development for the single entry way project.
- Network Upgrade – Mr. Warner described a project proposal to upgrade network systems to allow better coordination of COVID-19 response.
- Vaccine Cooler Purchases – Mr. Warner reported on new vaccine cooler purchases to allow testing supplies and future vaccine supplies to be stored at the health department.

10. Open Discussion

- COVID-19 Updates – Mr. Warner provided an update on current COVID-19 activities in the county.
- Levy Discussion – Mr. Warner reported that all required levy documentation has been submitted to the BOE.
- RN Position – Mr. Warner proposed the hiring of an additional nurse using the COVID-19 contact tracing funds. Dr. Karnes made a motion to approve this position. Mr. Edgington seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
